The question was asked about which day was the true Sabbath of God. Interestingly enough, they answered correctly that the true Sabbath is Saturday. However, they concluded by discussing that it was simply more convenient for them to keep Sunday. Can you imagine! For many of us that have studied out this issue and understand that God is the same today, yesterday, and tomorrow—that He never changes; and that the Biblical definition of sin is the transgression of His law; therefore, it is SO mind boggling how they could justify keeping another day simply for convenience! Yet, this is just one example of the work that needs to be completed for the saving of lost souls. Remember, that Christ says that His people will perish for a lack of knowledge (Hosea 4:6.) [And by the way, if this is a new thought for you as you are reading this, please call us for a free Bible study on the Sabbath and Sabbath keeping—you'll be glad you did!] Our "knowledge" needs ALWAYS to be based upon the Scriptures. The Bible has been preserved at a tremendous cost for centuries for the edifying of God's people.

Not long ago, we recorded a new 4-part series entitled, "The Plain, Straight Testimony Must Live." While preparing for these programs, our hearts continued to be led in the direction of personal and corporate preparation for our Lord's soon return. As we witness prophecy fulfilling before our very eyes, our hearts cry out to God for the saving of ourselves, our family and our friends. Pastor Kenny has stated that the Lord is continuing to draw him deeper into the various areas that sin needs to be eradicated from our lives. To further our thoughts in this direction, let's read this excerpt from the book, "Testimonies for the Church,"

Volume 3, page 520, "All are doubtless familiar with Achan's case. It is recorded in sacred history for all generations, but more especially for those upon whom the ends of the world are come. Joshua lay moaning upon his face before God because the people were obliged to make a disgraceful retreat before their enemies. The Lord bade Joshua arise: 'Get thee up; wherefore liest thou thus upon thy face? Have I humbled without cause by removing My presence from thee?' Does God forsake His people without a cause? No; He tells Joshua that there is a work for him to do before his prayer can be answered. 'Israel hath sinned, and they have also transgressed My covenant which I commanded them: for they have even taken of the accursed thing, and have also stolen, and dissembled also.' He declares: 'Neither will I be with you any more, except ye destroy the accursed from among you.' Here in this example we have some idea of the responsibility resting upon the church and the work that God requires them to do in order to have His presence. It is a sin in any church not to search for the cause of their darkness and of the afflictions which have been in the midst of them. The church...cannot be a living, prosperous church until they are more awake to the wrongs among them, which hinder the blessing of God from coming upon them. The church should not suffer their brethren in affliction to be wronged. These are the very ones that should awaken the sympathy of all hearts and call into exercise noble, benevolent feelings from all the followers of Christ. The true disciples of Christ will work in harmony with Him and, following His example, will help those who need help." Do you know someone in need of help? If we are honest with ourselves, we are all in need of help and spiritual growth! This is why we so value your partnering up with this ministry to proclaim the true gospel of Christ to the world. An Example to Live By...

"Jesus did not suppress one word of truth, but He uttered it always in love. He exercised the greatest tact and thoughtful, kind attention in His intercourse with the people. He was never rude, never needlessly spoke a severe word, never gave needless pain to a sensitive soul. He did not censure human weakness. He spoke the truth, but always in love. He denounced hypocrisy, unbelief, and iniquity; but tears were in His voice as He uttered His scathing rebukes. He wept over Jerusalem, the city He loved, which refused to receive Him, the way, the truth, and the life. They had rejected him, the Saviour, but He regarded them with pitying tenderness. His life was one of self-denial and thoughtful care for others. Every soul was precious in His eyes. While He ever bore Himself with divine dignity, He bowed with the tenderest regard to every member of the family of God. In all men He saw fallen souls whom it was His mission to save." Steps to Christ, pp. 12-13.

What life lessons we may draw from the paragraph above! We encourage you to reread it often. Ask God to make it a vital part of your Christian character. Implement its lessons in your responses to others, the way you correct your children, how you share the meatier testimonies of Biblical truth and so on. Truly our homes and churches would be a bit of Heaven on earth if we would reflect these qualities
